

## **Day 1 (Monday, June 13)- Packermania**

- 8:30-9:30: Introduction in room. Elementary Mac Lab - Use webguide and go to <http://www.packers.com/>  
Kids explore parts of the website, using the guide. Mrs. Glenetske will be in the lab to assist.
- 9:30: Phy Ed/Training Camp - Go tour the Bowler Football Field, announcer's booth, etc.
- 10:00: Packer history - Students view Lombardi video as they fill in video guide.
- 10:30: Crafts. Day one, students will start on beadwork. Some will use looms, some will use string & beads to make necklaces or bracelets.
- 11:00: Lunch & lunch recess.
- 11:30: Newsletter. Introduce - explain that the Packermania newsletter will be written on a weekly basis, and that Thursday is the deadline. Explain that the newsletter will be used in the weekly sports newscast, will be put on the Packermania web page, and distributed on Fridays. Explain the parts of the newsletter: **1)** 2 bios each week (Packers past & present) - maybe this section could be titled: "Getting to know \_\_\_\_\_." **2)** Fun Stuff (wordsearches, trivia, coloring, etc. **3)** "This Week In Packer Country" **4)** Pictures.  
Assign 2 or 3 students to write a newsletter article on **Vince Lombardi**, and 2 or 3 students to write a newsletter article on **Mike Sherman**. Assign 2 students to create a **wordfind**, to be put in their newsletter. Assign 2 students to report on our **daily activities** in Packermania. Assign a student to write captions for any pictures to be used in the newsletter. Assign 2-3 students to review **daily Packer news**, using newspaper articles, news reports from television, and other information from the internet.
- 12:00: Packermania T.V. Each student practices reading a short script. This is videotaped and the students can watch/review when they are done.
- 12:30: Daily Packer Math (DPM). For the first day, students will add, using the jersey numbers of Packer players. This could be done as a relay, in teams, or could be done on an individual basis. Starting on day 2, students will also use this time to enter their stats.
- 1:00: End of day wrap up. Pass out notes for home, etc. Any extra time can be used for finishing projects, clean up, recess, games, etc.
- 1:30: Dismissal

## Day 2 (Tuesday, June 14) - Packermania

- 8:30-9:30: Introduce what the goals are for the Packermania website.
- Show outline/skeleton of what the home page will look like, and explain each part. This could be done on a projector in the lab.
    - Home page, newsletter, activities, schedule, fun stuff, Packer art, etc.
  - Each student will get a blank piece of paper, and create a pencil drawing of the Kid's Zone page on the packers.com website. This activity would be a good way for kids to make connections and familiarize themselves with what a home page looks like. It might be a challenge to have the students reproduce by memory what they draw today.
- 9:30: Training Camp. Teachers record statistics of students' activities. Students will enter these on their charts during DPM (Daily Packer Math). Today, students will try **passing** and **kicking** skills. Each student gets 3 attempts.
- 10:00: Packer history. Students view **Ice Bowl** video as they fill in video guide.
- 10:30: Crafts. Students will look for rocks outside. They will be used to make Packer pet rocks tomorrow.
- 11:00: Lunch & lunch recess.
- 11:30: Students work on newsletter. Each student can have a notebook to work on their part of the newsletter. They can use books, newspaper articles, books, internet, to work on their assigned area. Explain that everyone will get a chance to do something different each week. Give each student/group a checklist/rubric to use as they work on the newsletter. Today, students will be assigned a topic.
- 12:00: Packermania T.V. Today, students can work on the backdrop for the newscast that will be taped on Friday.
- 12:30: DPM (Daily Packer Math) Students subtract, using Packer jersey numbers. Students record their stats from Training Camp, and chart their progress.
- 1:00: End of day wrap up. Pass out notes, etc. If there is extra time, students can finish projects, clean up, recess, games, etc.
- 1:30: Dismissal

### Day 3 (Wednesday, June 15) - Packermania

- 8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab: Students begin researching various Packer-related topics. Assign a topic, and hand out outlines. Use a checklist, and do a write-up as an example for students. Show students how to research/search using Google or Ask Jeeves.
- 9:30: Training Camp. Students will try the “**tire drill**” today. It will be set up outside. Each student tries twice. The teacher will record their stats. Students will record on a chart in DPM.
- 10:00: Packer History. (Continued from yesterday) Students watch part two from the **Ice Bowl** video as they fill in their video guide.
- 10:30: Crafts. Make pet rocks, using rocks that were gathered yesterday.
- 11:00: Lunch and lunch recess.
- 11:30: Students work on newsletter.
- 12:00: Packermania T.V. Students finish up on their backdrops, and students will be selected to anchor the newscast this week. (\*Explain that EVERYONE will get a chance to be an anchor in this class.)
- 12;30: DPM. Today, students will multiply, using Packer jersey numbers. Then, they will record their data from Training Camp.
- 1:00: End of day wrap up.

## Day 4 (Thursday, June 16) - Packermania

- 8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Powerpoint introduction. First, there will be a short introduction to what Powerpoint is. Next, the teacher will show an example of a Powerpoint presentation. When this is done, guide students through different parts of the Powerpoint program (opening it up, palette, etc.) Use the projector to visually guide students through this process. Students might try inserting a graphic and text into a slide (if time, and if students are ready)
- 9:30: Training Camp. Students will try the 40-yard dash today. Each student will get two attempts, and the teacher will record the times. Students will enter into their charts during DPM. \*Teacher will need a stopwatch.
- 10:00: Packer History: Lambeau Legend video. Students view video as they complete the video guide.
- 10:30: Crafts. Safety pin beads.
- 11:00: Lunch & lunch recess.
- 11:30: Students complete assigned newsletter parts. Today is the deadline.
- 12:00: Packer T.V.: Students set up the "studio," and the Packermania sports newscast is taped today. Students will view it tomorrow. The newsletter is the script. Parent permission is required before a student can be videotaped.
- 12:30: DPM. Students divide, using Packer jersey numbers. Then, students record their data from Training Camp.
- 1:00: End of day wrap up.
- 1:30: Dismissal

## **Day 5 Friday, June 17) - Packermania**

- 8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Fun Day. Kids go to the Kids' Zone section of packers.com. They try "Make A Packer," also, they can print out coloring pages or wordfinds, etc.
- 9:30: Training Camp. Students will try each Training Camp activity once, and the teacher will record the results.
- 10:00: Packer history. Students will watch part 2 of the **Lambeau Legend** video as they complete the video guide.
- 10:30: Crafts. Students will make placemats today. They will make a collage of scenes from Packer history. Once dry, these will be laminated, so they can be used as placemats.
- 11:00: Lunch & lunch recess.
- 11:30: "Extra time" for crafts, reading, games.
- 12:00: Packer T.V. Students watch their t.v. production. Give feedback afterwards. Give each student a scoresheet to be used to analyze newscast, after viewing newscast. It will be a rating (1-5) of each component of the sportscast. This can be used to lead a discussion after viewing the newscast.
- 12:30: DPM. Students record their Training Camp data on their charts. Also, they will record the results of the completed scoresheets from Packer T.V.
- 1:00: Packer prize drawing. The teacher picks tickets, awarded for participation this week, and those chosen can win a Packer prize.
- 1:30: Dismissal

## **Day 6 (Monday, June 20)- Packermania**

8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Powerpoint. Today, the students will begin working on their title page. Students will learn how to use Word Art, insert pictures, backgrounds, text boxes, and save their work.

9:30-10:00: Training Camp (Phy Ed) Students will take part in passing today. Three attempts each - teachers and students will measure and record. Results should be kept private, as the emphasis here is not on competition with each other, but rather, on putting forth one's best effort, being physically active, self-improvement, and of course, fun!

10:00- 10:30: Students watch clips of notable Packer games of the past. They will use a video guide as they view the video. A brief discussion, using the guide, can follow.

10:30-11:00: Crafts. Students make tie-dyed t-shirts using green and yellow dye. Materials needed: white t-shirts, Rit green and yellow dye, salt, water, buckets, rubber gloves, and hangers. Teachers take shirts home to wash and bring back to the students the next day.

11:00-11:30: Lunch / recess.

11:30 - 12:30: Time to work on the Packermania newsletter. This week's biographies are on middle linebackers Ray Nitschke and Nick Barnett. Assign students their newsletter responsibilities (Biographies, This Week In Packer Country, Packermania News, Fun Stuff (wordfind, trivia), and captions. Teacher can provide resources or students can do their own research if there is time.

12:30-1:00: Daily Packer Math (DPM). Teacher can create this sheet. Some examples are provided in our website. You can use the Packer roster, or create a math activity that is football related. Go over results when done.

1:00-1:30: End-of-day wrap up.

## **Day 7 (Tuesday, June 21)- Packermania**

8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Students continue to work on their Powerpoint presentations.

9:30-10:00: Training Camp. Students will work on punting skills today. Teacher measures and records results.

10:00-10:30: Students watch portion of Lambeau Legend video on “After Lombardi” Era. Students use video guide and participate in discussion afterwards.

10:30-11:00: Crafts. Students have a day to catch up on past projects.

11:00-11:30: Lunch / Recess

11:30-12:30: Students work on newsletter and begin making backdrop for Week 2 Packermania newscast.

12:30-1:00: Daily Packer Math.

1:00-1:30: End-of-day wrap up.

## **Day 8 (Wednesday, June 22)- Packermania**

- 8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Students continue working on title page of their Powerpoint presentations. Students can begin inserting pictures from Week 1, along with a paragraph for each picture. Students choose three pictures from Week 1, and write a paragraph for each picture. Students will create a six-page Powerpoint presentation using a title page, and an additional page for each week of Packermania (five weeks in all). Students must save their work after each session in the Mac Lab.
- 9:30-10:00: Training Camp. Today, students practice their kicking skills. Teachers measure and record.
- 10:00-10:30: Students watch Part One of the Packers/Patriots game from 1979. They will use the video guide as they watch, and discuss afterwards.
- 10:30-11:00: Students begin making their Packer ornament/block person. They need: wooden blocks, styrofoam "heads," Packer fabric, green and gold felt, glue, plastic eyes (from a craft shop), and small gold bells to glue on hats.
- 11:00-11:30: Lunch / Recess
- 11:30-12:00: Students work on newsletter.
- 12:00-12:30: Packer T.V. Students have a "Packermania BTV (Bowler Television) News" practice. Anchors are assigned roles in the newscast. Parent permission is required before a student can be videotaped.
- 12:30-1:00: Daily Packer Math.
- 1:00-1:30: End-of-day wrap up.



## **Day 9 (Thursday, June 23)- Packermania**

8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Students continue working on their Powerpoint presentations. They need to remember to save their work when they are done.

9:30-10:00: Training Camp. Today, students will work on the Tire Drill. Teachers will record student times. Students can have three attempts each.

10:00-10:30: Students watch Part Two of the Packers/Patriots game (1979), and complete the video guide. Discuss afterwards.

10:30-11:00: Crafts. Students finish their Packer ornament.

11:00-11:15: Students have lunch.

11:15-12:00: Students go to Home Econ. room for nutrition education with Miss Winnie. (This is a Shawano County program that is part of our summer school program each year.)

12:00-12:15: Recess

12:15 - 12:45: Students make final taping of the Packermania/BTV newscast.

12:45-1:00: Students view and discuss the Week Two Packermania newscast.

1:00-1:30: End-of-day wrap up. Note: tomorrow our class is going to Green Bay for a tour of Lambeau Field, and the Packer Hall Of Fame. Check with students to make sure all permission slips are in, and check to see which parents are coming along as chaperones.  
Pick three names for the weekly Packer prize drawing.

## **Day 10 (Friday, June 24)- Packermania**

Students arrive at 8:15, and leave for Green Bay by 8:30 sharp. Make sure students have a chance to use the restroom before they go, and make sure all students have permission slips, etc.

Teacher should bring along the Hall of Fame Video guide if they plan to use it. This is available on our website (<http://www.bowlersschool.net/>) if teacher would like to print a copy.

**10:30-12:00:** Packer Hall Of Fame Tour

**12:00-12:30:** Lunch in the Atrium (\*Teachers - Please check with the information booth first, or check ahead to make sure this is o.k.)

**12:30:** Head back to school

### **Day 11 (Monday, June 27)- Packermania**

8:30-10:30: Students participate in the Bernard Holsey Football Camp. Students may also view the morning practice with the class.

10:30-11:00: Crafts. Students begin working on their keychains. Beads, leather, and thread are needed. This project is a longer one, because of the detail-oriented work, so it will take a couple of weeks, however, other projects will be introduced as this one continues.

11:00-11:30: Lunch / Recess

11:30-12:30: Students begin work on the Week 3 Newsletter. Biographies this week are on Chester Marcol and Ryan Longwell. Assign students their responsibilities for the newsletter. Provide and assist with any needed resources.

12:30-1:00: Daily Packer Math.

1:00-1:30: End-of-day wrap up

### **Day 12 (Tuesday, June 28)- Packermania**

8:30-10:00: Students participate in the Bernard Holsey Football Camp. Students may also view the morning practice with the class.

10:00-10:30: Training Camp. Students will do the 40-yard dash. Teachers will time and record the individual times of the students. Each student can have two attempts.

10:30-11:00: Crafts. Students continue working on their keychains.

11:00-11:30: Lunch / Recess

11:30-12:30: Students continue working on the Week 3 Newsletter. Biographies this week are on Chester Marcol and Ryan Longwell. Assign students their responsibilities for the newsletter. Provide and assist with any needed resources.

12:30-1:00: Daily Packer Math.

1:00-1:30: End-of-day wrap up

### **Day 13 (Wednesday, June 29)- Packermania**

8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Students view a Powerpoint of their trip to Lambeau Field. The teacher has this made ahead of time. Next, the students begin work on their Week 2 Powerpoint slide. Make sure students save their work.

9:30-10:00: Training Camp. Today, students will work on a new skill - passing and receiving. No results need to be recorded. Students practice passing to different partners.

10:00-10:30: Students view the Packers-Bears game at Lambeau Field, from September 1980. This was a game where Chester Marcol, a Packer kicker, made a very dramatic play in overtime to win the game. Students use the video guide. This game will be viewed over a three-day period.

10:30-11:00: Crafts. Students continue to work on their keychains.

11:00-11:30: Lunch / Recess

11:30-12:30: Students work on the Week 3 Newsletter.

12:30-1:00: Daily Packer Math

1:00-1:30: End-of-day wrap up

### **Day 14 (Thursday, June 30)- Packermania**

8:30-9:30: Elementary Mac Lab. Students work on their Powerpoint presentations.

9:30-10:00: Training Camp. Students will do the Tire Drill today. Teachers will record the times of the students.

10:00-10:30: Students view Part 2 of the 1980 Packers/Bears game at Lambeau Field. They use the video guide, and discuss afterwards.
