It is that time of year again where it is time to look at the 2016-17 school year and picking out classes for next year. I will be meeting with the 8th grade through 11th grade students to go over the course descriptions book and ERVING course description book for selecting classes. The classes that are dual credit or ERVING classes are for Juniors and Seniors only.

I am happy to announce that we now have some more dual credit classes being offered through our staff as well as our ERVING partners in the Health Field. Students who are Juniors and Seniors could take up to 12-14 credits of Health Field related classes that would advance them in their NTC schooling. That is one semester of Technical College completed at the high school level by the time they graduate high school. Dual credit classes are classes that give the student high school credit and if they receive a B or higher the student will receive Technical College credit as well.

We will be posting the two course description books on our web page along with a planning sheet. Please take some time to look this over and talk to your son/daughter about their choices of classes. I plan on meeting with the class levels next week Monday, 1/11/16 throughout the day. Remember all students not graduating in 2016 will be required to take 3 math classes and 3 science classes before they graduate per DPI requirements. Class choices should be turned in no later than Friday, January 22, 2016. Please turn in ERVING choices by Monday, January 18, 2016. There will be baskets in the High School Office on the counter according to grade levels.
